

-- From Massachusetts: get on 495 North or 95 North (495 North pours you onto 95 North). You could also get onto 93 North to 495 North.

-- Continue north through New Hampshire and into Maine. You will have to pay a toll in York in order to continue on 95 north, as it becomes the Maine Turnpike.

-- The next exit after paying the toll is where you will get off -- Wells. It is exit number 19. It will say Wells, Sanford, Route 109, 9, etc.

-- at the bottom of the exit, you will go LEFT onto Route 109.

-- Take this all the way to a traffic light - about one and one half miles. This will be Route 1.

-- Take a LEFT -- heading north -- onto Route 1

-- Take the FIRST RIGHT onto Harbor Road. This is no more than 50 yards after you get onto Route 1, so you'll need to get over to the right immediately after you take that left onto Route 1. There is a big sign that says to the Harbor - fishing, boating, etc.

-- Follow Harbor Road all the way to the end. It will dead end at the Wells Town Wharf. The boat will be at the dock at the end of the Town Wharf - walk past the two little red buildings and down the ramp. If you have any trouble/questions, call us:

From Ogunquit: go north on Route 1 approx. 5 miles from Ogunquit center. Once in Wells, look on your RIGHT for Cumberland Farms at a traffic light. Just north of Cumby's is the Wells Fire Station. Harbor Road is immediately after the fire station on the RIGHT. Take this right onto Harbor Road; follow to end.

From Kennebunkport: Head west on Route 9. When you get to Route 1 take a LEFT. You will be taking a LEFT onto Harbor Road just before the Wells Fire Station and just before the traffic light for Route 109 West to the Maine Turnpike (Route 95).

For GPS users: Enter 300 Harbor Road, Wells, Maine 04090

There is plenty of free parking at the wharf or nearby. This is an old-fashioned harbor with only one restaurant and one boatyard -- not commercial or crowded at all.
